Pegasus (Nursery and Reception)



We have had a great start to the term. It is wonderful to see so many happy faces each morning, with the children excited to come to school and see what jobs they need to complete. The children are enjoying all the different activities planned and are showing a great willingness to have a go.

Toys from home - We may occasionally ask children to bring in objects or pictures related to our topic/learning, but we do ask that the children do not bring in their own toys from home. We would not want them to get lost or broken, particularly if they are 'special' in some way.

Snack Time - Children are provided with a choice of fruit, vegetables and milk/water if they wish each morning. These are Government funded so it is not necessary to send your child to school with a snack.

Water - We are keen to encourage children to drink water throughout the school day. Children are welcome to bring two drinks bottles, one for during the school day (containing water) and one for lunch (containing sugar free squash). The squash can stay in their lunchbox or if they are having school dinner then we can put it out of the way until lunchtime.

Spare clothes - Thank you to those parents who have already provided a bag of spare clothes; if you haven't already, please can you provide a spare change bag which includes pants, socks and pack of wipes that can be hung on your child's peg.

Wellies- The children will have the opportunity to spend lots of the day outside, regardless of the weather, so if you haven't already, please can you provide a pair of named wellies which can stay in school at all times.

Book bags (or a small rucksack/bag) - Children can use these to transport their work from the day and school books. You may wish to add 1 small keyring to their bag as this will help them recognise it from the others.

Reading/Reading Books - Information to follow separately.

Messy Play - We are asking for a £3 contribution towards messy play resources to support your child's learning and development. This might include coloured oats, shaving foam, Gloop, coloured spaghetti. Please make this contribution via ParentPay by the 27th September.

Named items - Please ensure that all clothes, shoes, lunch boxes, water bottles etc. are named from the start to help us match up the right items to the right child and to avoid items getting left at school at the end of the day.

End of day - If your child is being collected by someone else, please either let the adult on the door know in the morning (we will ask you to complete a reminder note) or email the school office

Unicorn Class



The children have made a great start to the year, and it is lovely to see so many happy faces in the morning. Mrs Faulkner, Miss Fellows and I are really looking forward to the year ahead. **Reading/Reading Books** - We have read with all children over the last couple of weeks and children have been allocated books at their appropriate level, which are coming home today. We encourage children to read at least 5 times per week, exploring their school books as well as others from home or the library.

Snacks - The children are still provided with fruit and vegetables for snack time, so you do not need to send one in.

Water - We are keen to encourage children to drink water throughout the school day in Unicorn Class. Children are welcome to bring two drinks bottles, one for during the school day (containing water) and one for lunch (containing sugar free squash). We will continue to encourage children to drink throughout the school day. Can we request that water/ squash is not stored with the children's reading books, as any liquid can damage a book and they are expensive to replace, thank you for your understanding.

Change of clothes - It would be useful for the children to have a change of clothes, including pants and socks. Please put these in a named carrier bag so that it can hang on their peg. Please ensure that all clothes coming into school are named. The children do not need wellies in school all the time this year. If they are needed for something, then we will let you know via Class Dojo.

Homework - Spelling homework will be sent home via Dojo on a Tuesday to be returned the following Monday. Mathematics and Reading homework will be completed in CPG booklets, these will need to be returned to school on a Monday to be marked. Information regarding this week's homework was posted on Class Dojo earlier in the week.

Book bags - Please could the children bring in their book bag everyday (there are some boxes in the cloakroom for storage); this way they can use them to take home anything they might do during the day as appropriate. Please make sure there is only ONE small keyring their bag. (They are more than welcome to display their 99 badges too.)
