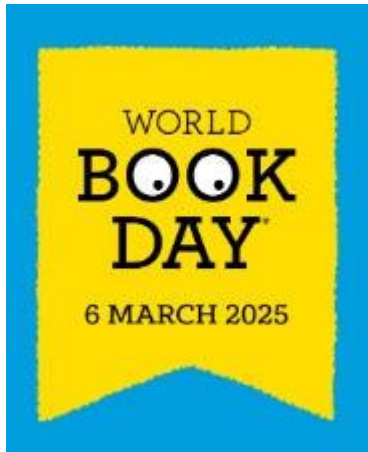

Sponsored Read

To celebrate and encourage a lifelong love of books and reading at home and at school, we will be running a ten-day sponsored read between Monday 24th February and Monday 10th March, 2025. Any funds raised will go to Friends of Hailey School who are currently raising money to create a whole school library space.

Our main aim is to foster a love of reading within our school and beyond. We appreciate that the cost of living has increased for many of us now so raising a huge amount of money is not our primary motivator. Spending a small amount of time each day reading with your child or as they move up the school, talking about chosen texts, is invaluable and this is what we really want to encourage. It is not just books that you can enjoy together but also comics, magazines, recipes, menus etc.,

A sponsorship form and a reading log are attached, and a paper copy has also been sent home with your child. The sponsored challenge will begin on Monday 24th February which allows you time to collect sponsors. There is a two-week period within which your child is encouraged to read for at least 10 days.

After the sponsored read, please send all sponsorship money into the school office in the week beginning Monday 10th March.
