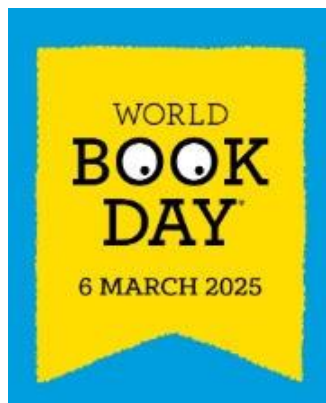

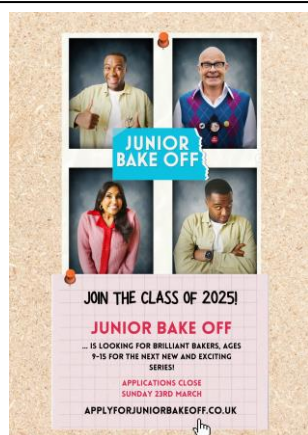
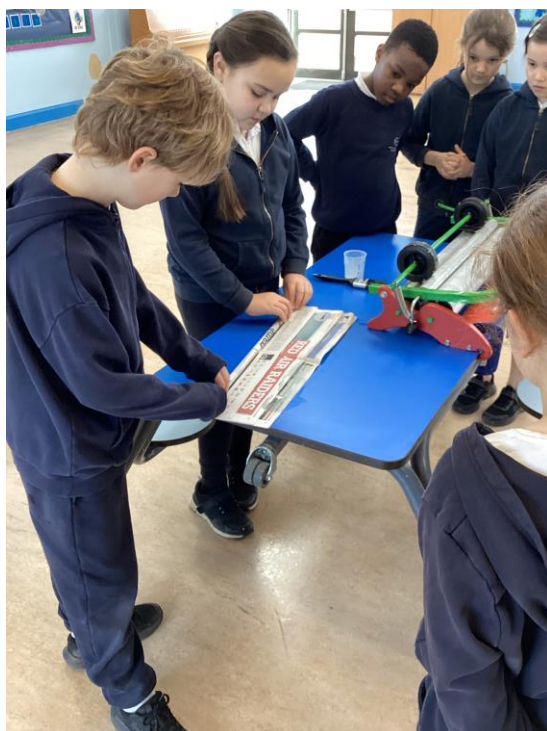


## **Parent Teacher Consultation Meetings**
